Floyd County 4-H Fair Queen & Princess Pageant

Rules & Responsibilities

The Floyd County 4-H Fair Queen & Princess Pageant will be held

Monday, June 29th at 7 p.m.

Floyd County 4-H Fairgrounds

2818 Green Valley Road, New Albany, IN

Awards will be given for Queen, 1st and 2nd runner ups.

Award will be given to Princess.

1. **Floyd Co 4-H Fair Queen** contestants must be at least 18 years of age by December 31, 2015 and not have had her 22nd birthday by June 1, 2016.
2. **Floyd Co 4-H Fair Princess** contestants must be 15 years of age by June 29th and not have had her 18th birthday by December 31, 2015.
3. Contestants must be unmarried and must never have been married.
4. Contestants must be an Indiana resident, a U.S. Citizen and represent her home county. One of her parents or her legal guardian must also be an Indiana resident. The only exception: she may reside in an adjoining Indiana County if the majority of her activities are in the county in which she enters the contest.
5. Contestants cannot have had a child or be knowingly pregnant.
6. Contestants must be an active member of at least one worthwhile organization within her community i.e. church group, girl scouts, 4-H, etc.
7. A Professional Model is not eligible for the State Fair Contest. (A Professional Model is one who earns her livelihood by modeling. A young woman who works for a High School or College Fashion Board is not considered a professional model.)
8. Any contestant who has competed in a State Fair Queen Pageant or contest cannot compete again.
9. Individuals may hold each title only once.
10. Applications for entry must be post marked on or before **Friday, May 29, 2015**.
11. The Floyd County 4-H Fair Queen Pageant's private judging will be held on **Monday June 29, 2015** at the *Purdue Technology Building*. Public judging is at 7 pm on **Monday, June 29** at the *Floyd County 4-H Fairgrounds*.

12. Each contestant must be sponsored by a club, organization, business or individual.
13. Sponsorship requires a \$50 tax deductible fee. Checks must accompany the entry application and be made payable to The Floyd County 4-H Corporation (note on checks “2015 4-H Queen Pageant”)
14. The Floyd County 4-H Fair Queen & Princess **MUST** be available to participate in activities during the Floyd County 4-H Fair **June 29 – July 4, 2015**.
15. The **Floyd County 4-H Fair Queen** is expected to advance to the Indiana State Fair Queen Pageant if age requirements met. The State Fair Queen Contest is held **January 8-10, 2016**. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the Floyd County 4-H Fair title and all awards. The Indiana State Fair will provide accommodations for the contestant at the Indiana State Fairgrounds. There is no advancement for the Floyd County Fair Princess.
16. Points and score sheets are for the judges assessments only, and will not be returned to participants. Judges scoring decisions are final.
17. The Floyd County 4-H Fair Contestant will be judged based on poise, personality, and the ability to converse. This judging is divided into the following three (3) categories:
- **3:00 pm @ Purdue Technology Building (Charlestown Road)**
 - **Category I: Private Interview in Professional Wear - 50 pts**
 - Ability to converse - 20 pts
 - Posture & Poise - 15 pts
 - Personality - 10 pts
 - Overall Impression - 5 pts
 - **7:00 pm @ Floyd County 4-H Fairgrounds (Green Valley Road)**
 - **Category II: Business Attire - 25 pts**
 - Personality – 10 pts
 - On Stage Question - 15 pts
 - **Category III: Evening Gown - 30 pts**
 - Stage Presence - 15 pts
 - Poise - 5 pts
 - Overall Impression - 10 pts
 - **Final Judges Placings**
